

## How to claim CME credits for your participation in the *Maintaining and Optimizing your Practice During Times of Rapid Change* AMA Webinar Series

### Background

To provide timely information and education for physicians in Alberta, the AMA has been offering a CME accredited webinar series titled 'Maintaining and Optimizing your Practice during Times of Rapid Change'. To facilitate the administration of participation certificates, AMA has developed an online application in the Member's dashboard for self-serve access to certificates. Attendance is tracked via name and email collected from the Zoom platform and reconciled with AMA records. Please allow up to 2 weeks post-webinar for certificates to become available.

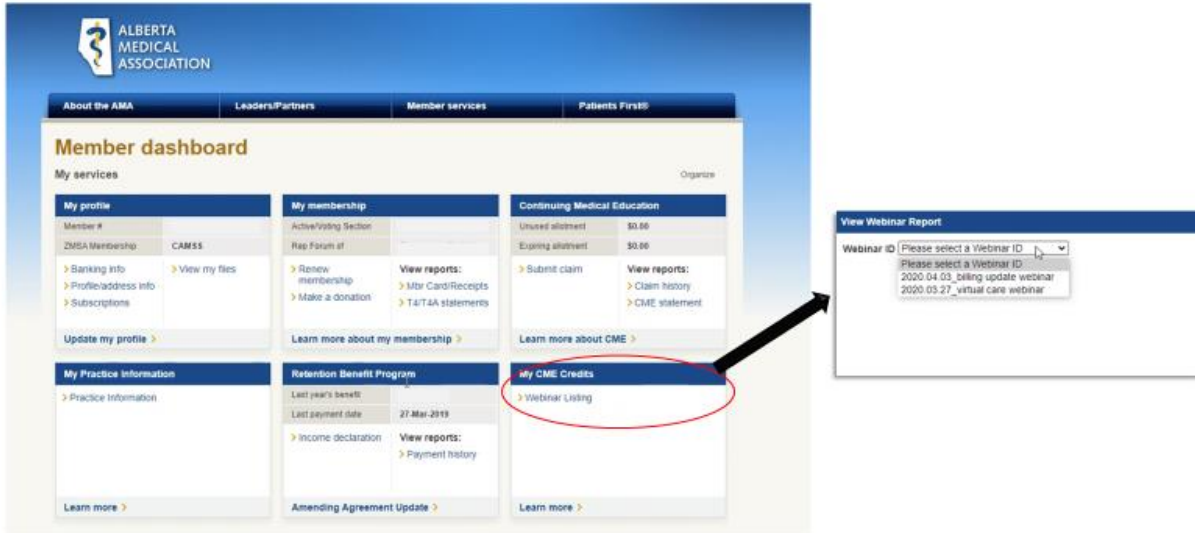
