Did you know that most physicians will earn enough continuing professional development (CPD) credits throughout a year to claim the full continuing medical education benefit amount (\$2,200)? Most physicians can claim the full CME allotment by submitting a claim for "overhead allowance."

If you haven't claimed for your 2022/23 CME yet (for expenses incurred between April 1, 2022, and March 31, 2023), be sure to do so before the July 31, 2023 deadline. After this date allotments will be forfeited. [Learn more](#)
