As reported, [government is reorganizing](#) Alberta Health Services and the health system into four provincial health agencies: primary care; acute care; continuing care; and mental health and addictions.

To provide physician perspective on this system reorganization, AMA and Alberta Health have formed a working table that will provide the Associate Deputy Minister, Deputy Minister and Minister of Health with advice and recommendations, including, but not limited to:

- Ensuring the physician perspective is considered to inform health system policy change under the Health System Refocus.
- Leveraging the physician experience to ensure effective implementation of the Refocus, including support for local decision-making.

The call for applications to serve in this collaborative effort is now open. We are looking for physician leader expertise in the four sectors.
