

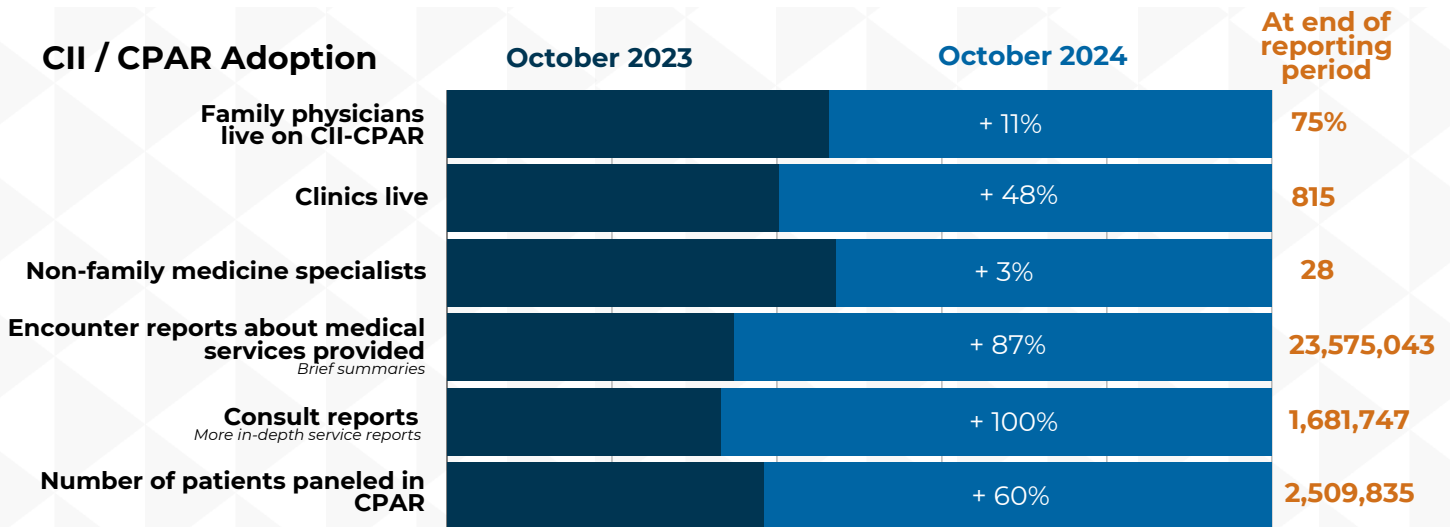


# ACTT CII/CPAR

A critical tool to enhance communication between providers across the province and improve continuity of care

## October 2023 - October 2024

**Community Information Integration & Central Patient Attachment Registry (CII / CPAR)** identifies relationships between patients and their primary provider, enabling vital patient health information to be shared with Alberta Netcare directly from their electronic medical record (EMR). It also enables eNotifications to be sent to providers when their patients are seen in emergency departments, have a hospital admission or day surgery.
