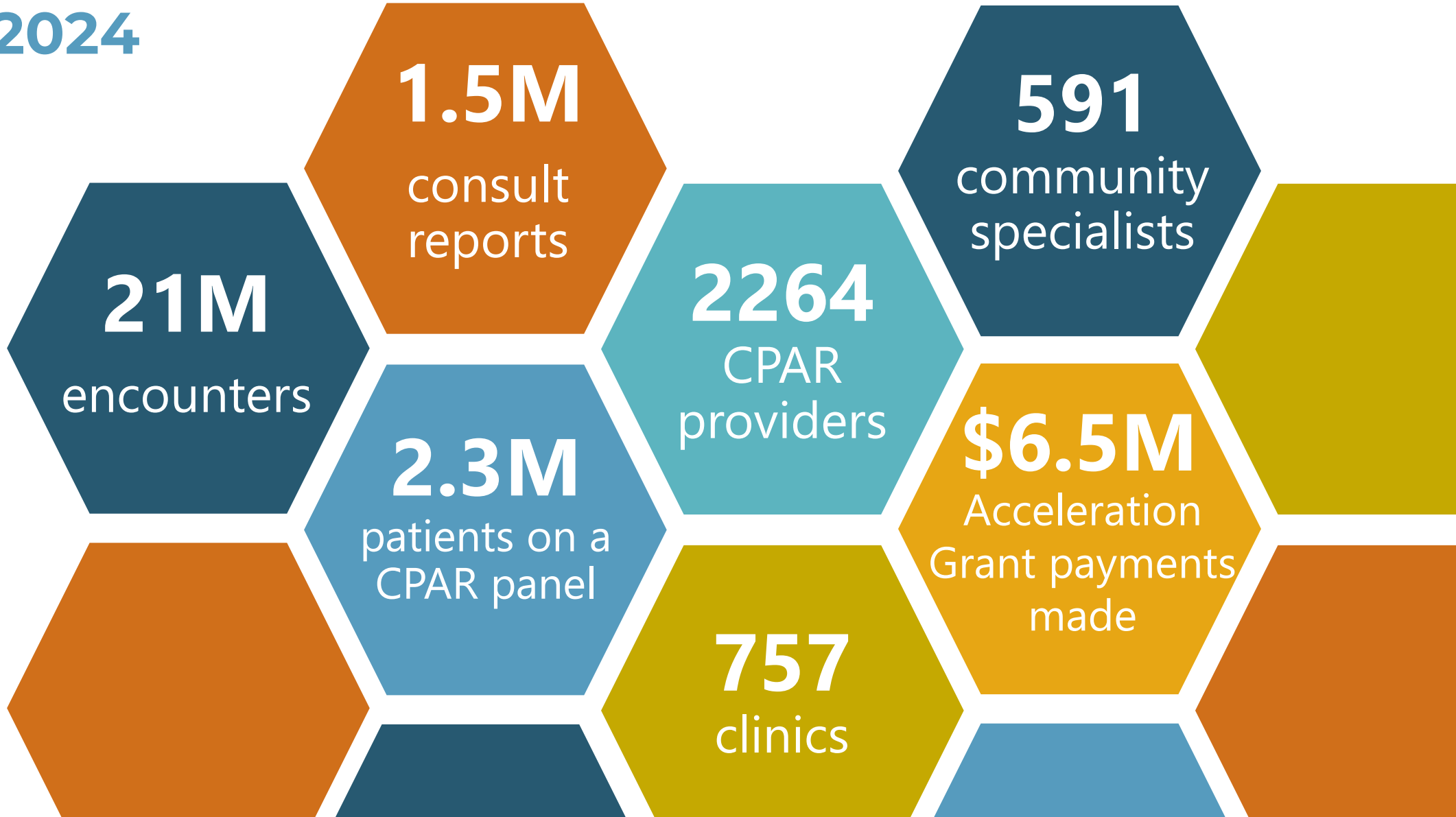

# PCCM Panel Prep: Take control of your panel size

PMSP/TFP revealed significant confusion about various “panel sizes” and CPAR. The new funding model (PCCM) **may** use a similar panel size calculation, so let’s get physician’s panel sizes more accurate before the funding model launches.
