History: I had the pleasure of seeing Albus Test today at my practice. Albus is a 70 year old Male that has been experiencing issues with high self-monitored blood glucose levels, and symptoms consistent with hyperglycemia (fatigue, polydipsia, polyuria).

Examination: Appears tired but otherwise well. CBG in office is 11.8, and reports eating 1 piece of whole wheat toast and black coffee ~ 3 hours ago. A1C last week = 8.6%. Saw diabetes RD last week; consult reports suggests fairly balanced diet overall; no excessive added sugar or refined carb intake, and adequate protein and fibre at most meals. PA: walking briskly for 15-20 minutes 3/7 now, feels this is all they can manage at this time. Reports taking metformin 1000mg bid consistently, no apparent s/e, and reports no missed doses.

Pt and his wife are frustrated that BG remains high (though improved from previous) despite dietary and activity changes, and good adherence to medications.

Foot exam reveals intact skin, no immediate concerns, but moderate loss of sensation in L and R heel and toes.
