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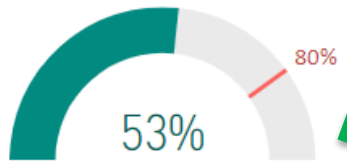

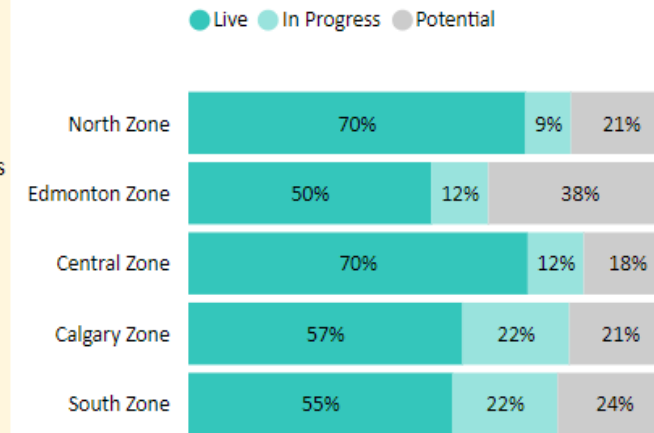

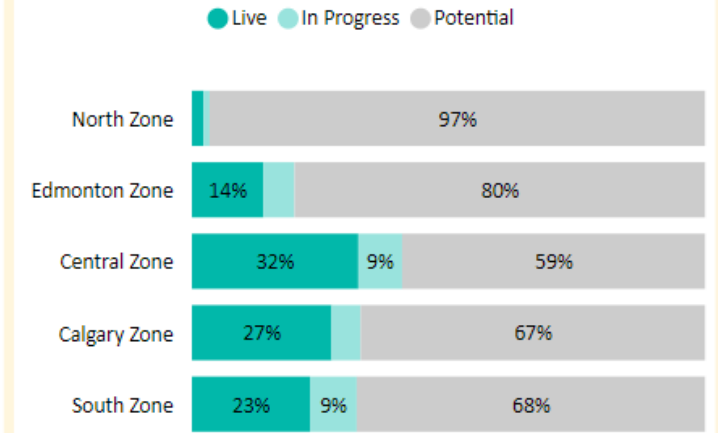

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Get Ready for PCCM

Physician Comprehensive Compensation Model

The PCCM is a new, modernized model that will provide family physicians and rural generalists who primarily practice in clinics and are currently paid through fee-for-service, or other compensation models, with a new compensation option.

You may need to be on **CII/CPAR** to participate in **PCCM**.

Get Ready for PCCM

- **73%** of PCN Family Physicians have already signed up for CII/CPAR
- PMSP panel sizes are calculated quarterly; going live on CII/CPAR may increase your panel size estimate
- Go live soon and be automatically eligible for up to \$2600 in Acceleration Grant funds



Get Ready for PCCM

The onboarding process can take time. **Don't wait** until PCCM is fully launched to get started.
