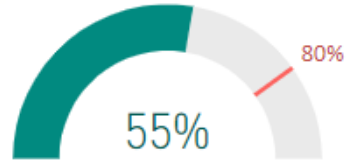

47% live and 11% in progress

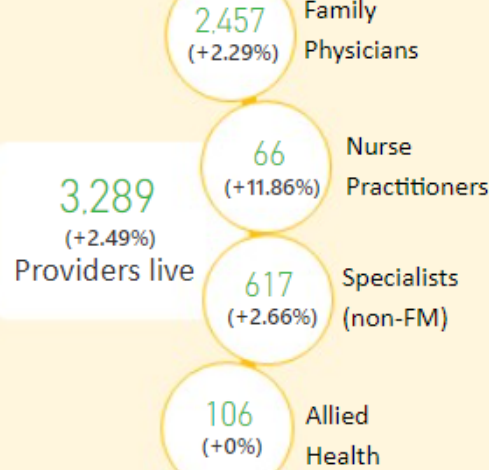

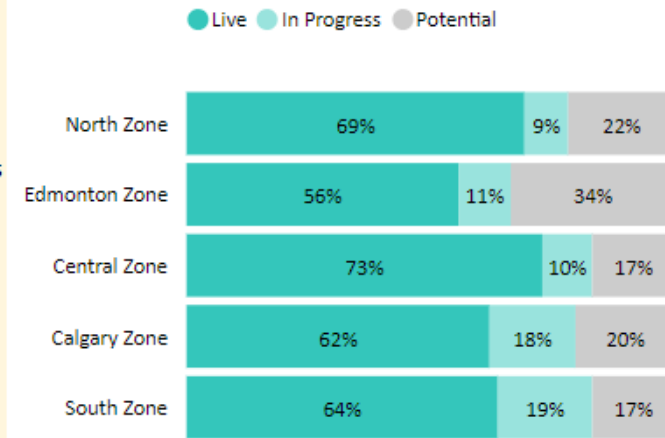

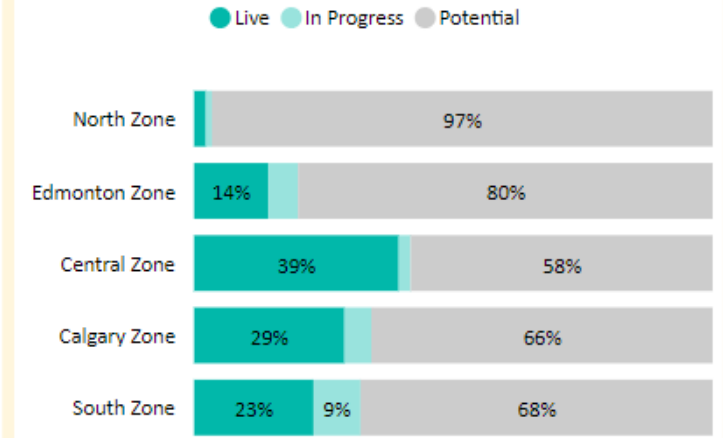


PCN Physicians Participation



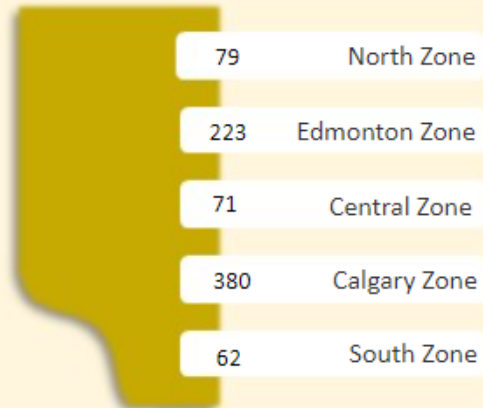

Introduction

What is CII/CPAR?

CII/CPAR enables physicians and their teams to share patient information to Alberta Netcare directly from their electronic medical record (EMR).

CII/CPAR enhances communication amongst providers by enabling the sharing of important healthcare information across the province. This two-way connection between clinic EMRs and Alberta Netcare is improving continuity of care between the Patient’s Medical Home and Health Neighbourhood.

CII allows providers to send select patient information to Alberta Netcare including consult letters and information about patient visits to contribute to Community Encounter Digests (CEDs).

CII Development Updates



- **PFDs**

- CII now has the ability to upload PFD/PFTs to the Investigations folder in Netcare
- Currently only works for Healthquest, but...
- Still reach out to us with any interested clinics using any CII-conformed EMR

- **Patient Summary**

- A few Healthquest clinics will start testing Patient Summary in November
- Other vendors will eventually work on implementing this
