What is CII/CPAR?



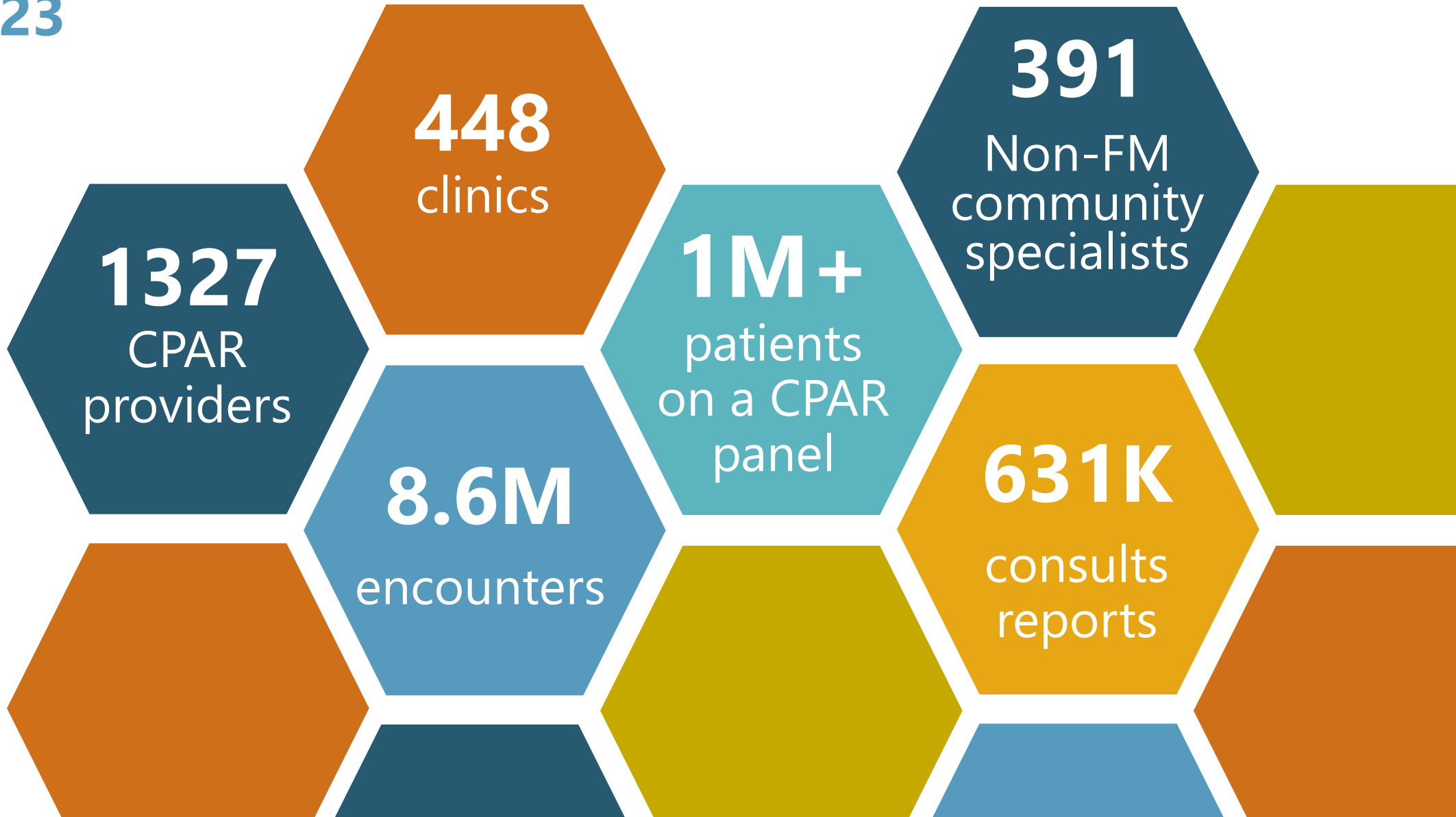
CII/CPAR

- Community Information Integration & Central Patient Attachment Registry
- CII/CPAR was requested by physicians
- Enables two-way patient information flow between Alberta Netcare & clinic electronic medical record
 - CII: send select information including consult letters to Alberta Netcare and information about patient visits to Community Encounter Digest
 - CPAR: identifies relationships between patients and their primary provider and enables eNotifications
- It enhances communication from across the province
- Improves continuity of care between the Patient's Medical Home & Health Neighbourhood

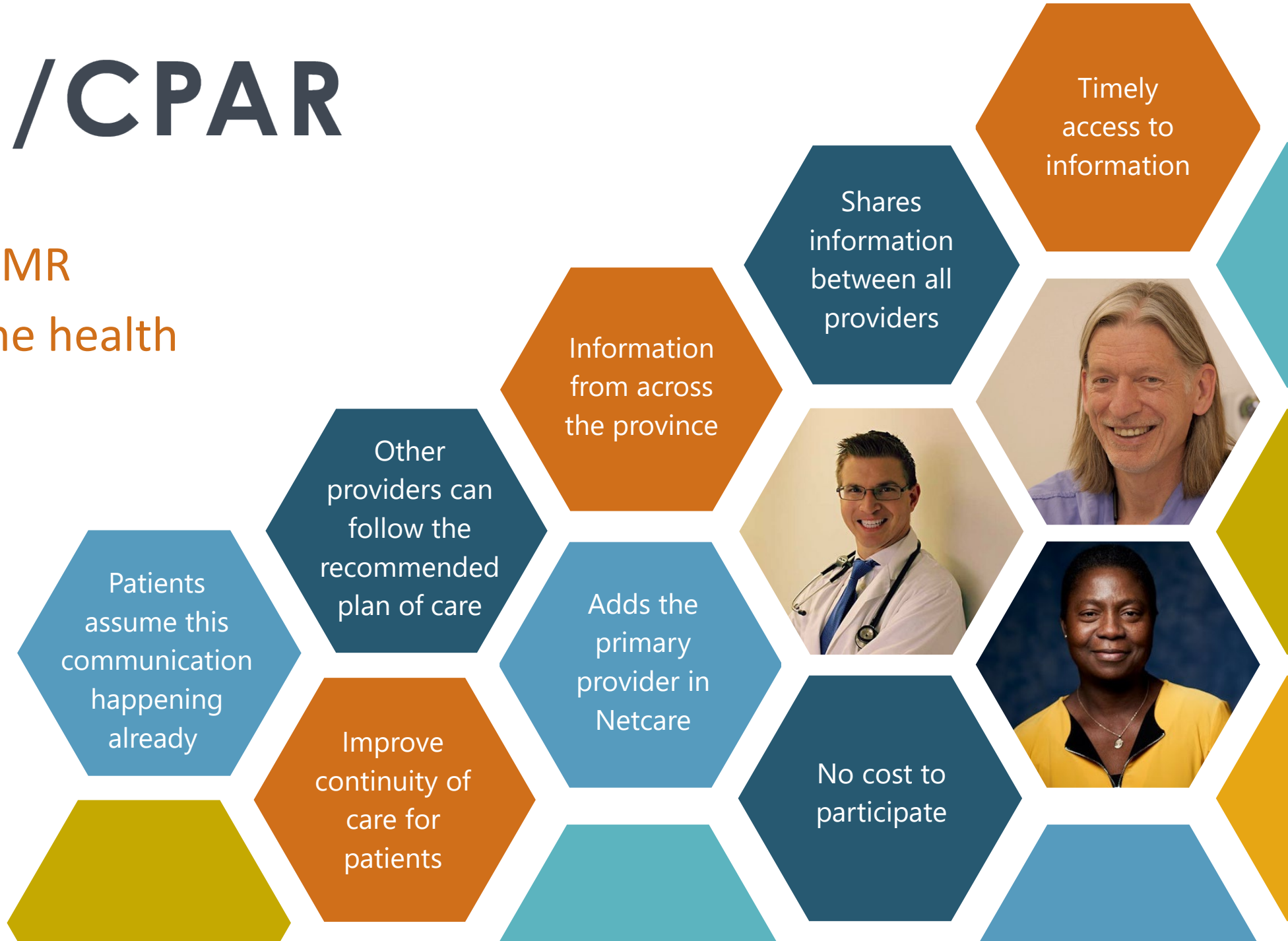

What is the CII/CPAR Acceleration Grant?



Acceleration Grant Highlights

- Part of the 2022 physician agreement
- Compensate physicians for their time and administrative requirements to enrol and participate in CII/CPAR
- Funded entirely by Alberta Health
- \$12M to incent CII/CPAR uptake
 - Family medicine & non-family medicine
- “First come, first served basis” until funding limit reached



Payment Details

- New CII/CPAR sign-ups and physicians already live on CII/CPAR are eligible
- Alberta Health will track which physicians are eligible for payment
- AMA will be responsible for distributing the payments
- Information about how physicians will receive their payments will be provided in the coming weeks
 - Like other agreements payments, these will be managed through the member dashboard



Who is Eligible?

Must meet **all** of the following criteria:

1. Family physicians, general practitioners or non-family medicine specialists
2. If they have a practice:
 - a) In the community (including a PCN clinic), **or**
 - b) In an AHS-operated primary care clinic (E.g., Family Care Clinics, Family Medicine Clinics)
3. Must be on a fully conformed EMR vendor system:
 - Accuro
 - Healthquest
 - CHR
 - Med Access
 - PS Suite
 - Wolf
 - Ava (once they are conformed)
 - Connect Care (primary care clinics)

Payment Amounts & Timing



1

First Payment for Enrollment

A one-time payment of \$1000 for the first data submission to CII/CPAR for currently enrolled and newly participating physicians.

2

Second Payment for Data Submission

After at least three months of data submitted to CII/CPAR.

Panel and Encounter

A one-time payment of \$1,600 for submitting patient panel and encounter data.

OR

Encounter Only

A one-time payment of \$750 for uploading encounters only.

OR

Consult Reports

A one-time payment of \$1000 for submitting consult reports.

Additional Details



- Physicians who work in multiple clinics that are using CII/CPAR will only be eligible for a **single** enrollment payment, and a single data submission payment
- Physicians **cannot** receive multiple data submission payments
 - They will just receive the highest value payment
- Those submitting panels
 - Must have a panel administrator
 - Minimum panel size
 - Greater than 50 patients for pediatricians
 - Greater than 200 patients for family physicians & general practitioners
- Those submitting consults
 - Must submit at least 30 consult reports over a three-month period



Prerequisites To Go Live

A clinic must:

1. Be using a conformed EMR
2. Be live on Alberta Netcare Portal
3. Have an up-to-date Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA)
4. Be "Panel Ready" if applicable
